



The 2020 Census and Local Update of Census Addresses Program

As 2017 comes to a close and the next Census approaches (2020), the Census Bureau has begun collaborating with local governments in order to prepare for their Local Update of Census Addresses (LUCA). LUCA represents an opportunity for tribal, state, county, and local governments to compare a list of their addresses with the Census Bureau's Master Address File (MAF). Information given to the Census Bureau during LUCA will be used to administer the 2020 Census. It is imperative that as many cities in the region sign up for LUCA as possible. Having correct addresses will result in a better county for your jurisdiction, which will in turn result in more money for your community from revenue-sharing based upon population (e.g. road use tax, CDBG eligibility).
