2025 PARTNERSHIP PROGRAM



Merchants Park was dedicated in 1949 and has been a consistent and strong visitor draw for Carroll. This classic field has been the site of thousands of college, junior college, semi-pro, high school, legion and specialty league games and tournaments. In 2021, the Iowa High School State Baseball Tournament returned to Carroll. The Carroll Merchants returned in 2022 as a member of the long-standing MINK Summer Collegiate Baseball League. Region XII COG worked with the City of Carroll to secure over \$340,000 in grant funding from various sources including Enhance Iowa CAT program, Community Foundation of Carroll County, the Iowa West Foundation, the Carroll Foundation, Pella Rolscreen Foundation, and the Timmerman Charitable Trust to assist with over \$1.3-million dollars in improvements completed in 2025.



egion XII Council of Governments (COG) invites private, non-government businesses and organizations to become a part of the COG's mission to provide various needed services to the region's cities and counties. Since 1973, Region XII has been actively serving the citizens of Audubon, Carroll, Crawford, Greene, Guthrie, & Sac Counties. The COG also serves associate member cities in Dallas County: Dallas Center, De Soto, Perry, Redfield, and Woodward.

For most of the COG's history, professional services have been supported through a basic per-capita fee paid by member counties, and various state, federal, and local government sources. Partnership Program investments are critical in allowing the COG the ability to leverage more funds to provide locally-driven services.



COG staff manages housing programs which include housing rehabilitation, housing subdivision development, homeownership assistance, and speculative construction. The COG also administers the COG Housing Trust Fund in the region, which provides assistance to very low income

lowa Transit (WIT) offers public transit services to all those who may need transportation. WIT is funded from several sources including the Iowa DOT, the Federal Transit Administration, local governments, and fares and donations.



Region XII with the assistance of the USDA has established a new Iowa Meat & Poultry Revolving Loan Fund to facilitate financing for the start-up, expansion, and operation of entities engaged in primary processing (slaughter) or further processing of meat and poultry. Processors within the entire State of Iowa are eligible.

IOWA WASTE EXCHANGE

The Iowa Waste Exchange (IWE) matches businesses with excess waste to others seeking materials in order to reduce waste in the state's landfills. Region XII COG continues to manage the state-wide IWE Contract and staffs two of the five IWE districts. Region XII staff covers 54 of the state's 99 counties.
